



Announcement of the Faculty of Humanities, Chiang Mai University Academic Staff Recruitment

The Faculty of Humanities is seeking applications to fill one available full-time academic staff position (5-year fixed-term, renewable), position number: EP170033, to be working at the Faculty's Integrative Center for Humanities Innovation (ICHI). The main responsibilities will include teaching in the international undergraduate program, helping develop an international graduate program, finding research grants and producing publications, and helping other staffs manage the center. Applicants must have qualifications as follows:

A. Qualifications

1. Must have the general qualifications according to item number 6 in the regulations on human resource management of Chiang Mai University
2. Must hold a doctoral degree or equivalent degree in urban studies, urban history, urban cultural studies or urban humanities.
3. Must hold English language proficiency score/level from TOEFL or IELTS or CMU-eTEGS. The score/level must be according to the university announcement on English language qualification for newly hired staffs (announced on 21 March 2017, see attached document below). Exception is for applicants who graduated from universities in the countries where English is an official language.
4. Must not be the person who applied for early retirement package in Thai governmental units.

B. Dates, Times, and Applications

Applicants can contact the human resource office located on 2nd floor of HB7 building, the Faculty of Humanities, for application form. Alternatively, applicants can email the office at pattira.c@cmu.ac.th to obtain the electronic application form. The application period is from now until 2nd September 2022, 16.00 hrs. C. Required documents

Applicants must submit these documents when launching the applications:

7. English proficiency score/level from TOEFL, IELTS, or CMU- eTEGS that has not expired. Exception is for applicants who graduated from universities in the countries where English is an official language. The program must be more than 2 years.

D. Recruitment procedures

1. The faculty will announce the names of qualified applicants on the faculty's website www.human.cmu.ac.th on 16th September 2022.
2. Applicants attend academic and teaching assessments, which consist of a) academic presentation in English and b) teaching test, during 25th – 26th October 2022. (Applicants will be notified for specific place, date, and time later).
3. The faculty will announce the names of applicants who are qualified for the interview round on 27th October 2022. (The qualified applicants will have to receive more than 70% from the academic and teaching assessments).
4. Applicants who are qualified to attend the interview round must attend the psychological assessment at the faculty on 28th October 2022, from 09.00 – 12.00 hrs. Alternatively, applicants who live in abroad or in other provinces of Thailand can send the psychological assessment certificate received from accredited institution in their areas to the faculty instead of coming to take psychological assessment at the faculty. It must be before the interview time.
5. The interview round will be organized on 31st October 2022. (Applicants will be notified for specific place, date and time later)
6. The faculty will announce the name of a successful candidate in the website www.human.cmu.ac.th on 1st November 2022.
