



Announcement of the Faculty of Humanities, Chiang Mai University
Academic Staff Recruitment

The Faculty of Humanities is seeking applications to fill one available full-time academic staff position (continuing full-time employment with 5-year contract), position no. EP170038. The successful candidate will be working in Division of Pali, Sanskrit, and Hindi, Department of Eastern Languages. Applicants must have qualifications as follows:

A. Qualifications

1. Must have the general qualifications according to item number 6 in the regulations on human resource management of Chiang Mai University
2. Must hold a doctoral degree or during an actual period of study Ph.D. in the field of Hindi Language, Hindi Literature, Comparative Hindi Literature, or in any related field.
3. Has an English language proficiency score from the recognized examination, and for the minimum of, as follows:
 - a. TOEFL (Score) = PBT/ITP 450 or CBT 133 or IBT 45
 - b. IELTS (Level) = 5
 - c. CMU-e TEGS (Score) = 60

Exception is for applicants who graduated from universities in the countries where English is an official language.

4. Must not be the person who applied for early retirement package in Thai governmental units.

B. Dates, Times, and Applications

C. Required documents

Applicants must submit these documents when launching the applications:

1. All educational degrees and transcripts 1 copy
2. Residential certificate or official information 1 copy
3. Identification card or passport 1 copy
4. Passport photo (no hat and glasses), 3x4 cm in size 1 photo
5. Medical certificate (issued no more than 1 month) 1 copy
6. Applicant's CV which shows the details of the doctoral thesis/dissertation and publications after graduation

7. English proficiency score/level from TOEFL, IELTS, or CMU- eTEGS that has not expired. Exception is for applicants who graduated from universities in the countries where English is an official language. The program must be more than 2 years.

D. Recruitment procedures

1. The faculty will announce the names of qualified applicants on the faculty's website www.human.cmu.ac.th on 10th June 2022.
2. Applicants attend the written exam on 13th June 2022, from 13.30 hrs. onwards.
3. The faculty will announce the names of applicants who are qualified for interview round on 16th June 2022. (The qualified applicants will have to have more than 70% in the written exam)
4. Applicants who are qualified to attend the interview round must attend the psychological assessment at the faculty on 20th June 2022, from 09.00 – 12.00 hrs. Alternatively, applicants who live in abroad or in other provinces can send the psychological assessment certificate received from accredited institution in their areas to the faculty later.
5. The interview round will be organized on 20th June 2022, from 13.30 hrs. onwards.
6. The faculty will announce the name of successful candidate in the website www.human.cmu.ac.th on 24th June 2022.
7. Please be aware that due to the uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic situation, the faculty may adjust some of the recruitment procedures to be online or via other means.
