As the Faculty of Humanities Chiang Mai University has announced the TFL Undergraduate Scholarship for Students from CLMV Countries 2025 (for student ID 68...) to study in the Bachelor of Arts Program in Thai as a Foreign Language (International Program), the selection process has now completed. The selected candidate is as follows:

Scholarship recipient: Ms. Htet Wai Moe

Alternate candidate: Miss Thin Yanant Wai

The scholarship recipient must confirm acceptance by emailing tfl@cmu.ac.th by March 7, 2025. Failure to do so will be considered a declination of the scholarship, and the alternate candidate will be contacted to proceed with the next steps.

The scholarship will be granted for regular semesters, starting from Semester 1, Academic Year 2025, through Semester 2, Academic Year 2028, with a financial grant of 55,000 baht (fifty-five thousand baht) per semester. Additionally, the recipient will receive one round-trip international travel allowance.

The recipient must maintain a grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.25 every semester. If the recipient's grade point average (GPAX) falls below 3.25, the scholarship will be suspended for the subsequent semester.
